## About it

There are two basic reasons why people aren't mature. One is time and the other is health. The world is full of immature people. Some are children who are healthy but have not had the time to grow. Others have had adequate time but have failed to mature either physically, emotionally or socially. Their immaturity can indicate either a health problem or an unhealthy growth environment. Spiritual growth is very similar to growth in these other areas of life.
